Beans – Planting Guidelines

- Select planting location with well drained soils. If poor drainage plant on elevated rows (or mounds), or amend soil with sand and gravel.
 Soil pH of 5.5-7 is optimum.
- 2. Initial planting after last estimated frost.
- 3. If variety will benefit from trellising place trellis prior to planting.
- 4. Plant seeds one inch deep. Do not soak beans prior to planting.
- 5. Plant seeds 4 inches apart. Water in if soil is dry.
- 6. When plants reach top of trellis top off leading shoot.
- 7. Harvest every 2-3 days for maximum production.
- 8. Replant every 2-3 weeks for extending season.
- 9. Cut plant at base once production tappers off. Leave roots in soil.
- 10.Rotate planting location each year.
