Mr. Blumenfeld served as the Regional Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for Nevada, California, Arizona and Hawaii (2009-2016), he also was the Director of the San Francisco Department of the Environment (2001-2009), chaired the first United Nations World Environment Day held in the U.S. (2005), and founded the Business Council on Climate Change and Green Cities California. He has worked for non-profits including the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) and the International Fund for Animal Welfare (IFAW) where he helped protect millions of acres for wildlife and held corporations accountable. He is a trusted source for environmental stories and appears frequently in the New York Times, BBC, Economist, Los Angeles Times, and NPR.
